- a. Hale – No updates on additional computers
- b. Center
 - i. 480 additional responses on all students
 - ii. Cohorts are continuing to be refined
 - iii. Hybrid – 375; (Some students attending twice due to high need); Remote - 89
 - iv. Class lists will go out tomorrow
 - v. Staff returned yesterday
 - vi. Significant changes coming to pick up and drop off. Communications will be going out to parents shortly
 - vii. HVAC systems have been audited.

4) 2020/2021 Academic Year Plans

- a. Fundraising –
 - i. Programming funds currently available - - \$23,842
 - ii. Box Tops
 - 1. Will not continue collecting in 2020/2021. Will continue with online collection
 - iii. Will not begin year with fundraising drive. Will determine whether to run a drive depending on any needs arising during the school year
 - 1. Let the Principals know funds exist should there be areas where funding is needed
 - 2. If there is a need for supplies (air purifiers, masks, etc), principals will communicate with SPTO
- b. In school programming from last year
 - i. Reptile event – never cashed check
 - ii. Discovery museum – remains outstanding
- c. Programming for 20/21 School Year

- i. Hesitant to add in more virtual events for kids
- ii. If there is a place to help out teachers, that is where programming could make sense
- iii. Could we try for a trunk-or-treat?
 - 1. Likely not on school grounds. Would need to find somewhere offsite
 - 2. Are there things we can do outside of school that show we're a community, or think about differently to allow students to show community
